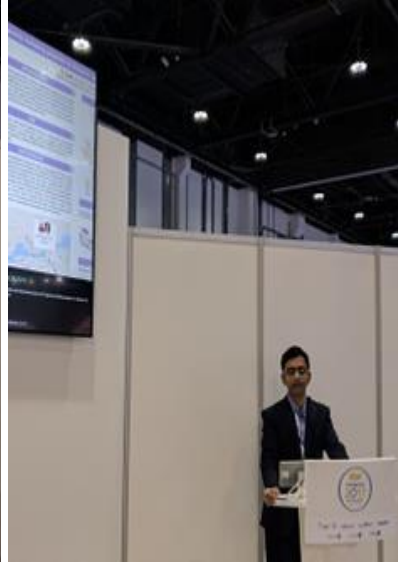

Advocacy and Collaborations

The conference was an ideal platform for the advocacy of the PHFI capacity building programs. Many delegate around the world were apprised about PHFI activities as well as the capacity building initiatives in chronic conditions. The conference served as an excellent platform for the advocacy of our various capacity building initiatives especially Certificate Course in Evidence Based Diabetes Management (CCEBDM), Certificate Course in Gestational Diabetes Mellitus (CCGDM), Advanced Certificate Course in Management of Diabetes and Cardiovascular Disease (ACMDC) and Certificate Course in Evidence Based Management of Diabetic Retinopathy (CCDR) along with other initiatives. Various diabetes associations have shown their keen interest to collaborate with PHFI. We had detailed discussion with Argentina Diabetes Association, Poland Diabetes Association, Canada Diabetes Association, Republic of Congo Diabetes Association, Morocco and Egypt Diabetes Association to name a few.

Major collaboration done during the conference are as follows:-

1. Collaboration between Myanmar Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (MSEM) & PHFI

During the conference an impactful meeting was held with the Myanmar Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (MSEM) leadership. The meeting was attended by Prof. Tint Swe Latt, ***Emeritus Professor***, University of Medicine 2, Yangon & ***President***, Myanmar Diabetes Association (MmDA) and Prof. Than Than Aye, President of MSEM & Vice President MmDA, Prof. Ko Ko, HoD, Dept. of Diabetes & Endocrinology, University of Medicine-2 and team. The MSEM leadership were updated on the capacity building model of PHFI and various certificate courses. The MSEM leadership agreed to do partnership with PHFI starting with our diabetes course followed by others. MSEM will shortly invite PHFI for the sensitization meeting in 2nd week of February 2018 for the official launch of the collaboration.



2. Collaboration between East African Diabetes Study Group (EADSG) & PHFI

The second meeting was held with East African Diabetes Study Group (EADSG) under Dr. Silver Bahendeka, Chair of the 4th The East Africa Diabetes Study Group (EADSG). They have invited PHFI to participate in the 4th EADSG Congress & Scientific Session from 10th -14th March 2018 at Kigali Convention Center, Rwanda. The courses will be launched during the conference.

3. Collaboration between Sri Lanka College of Endocrinologists (SLCE) & PHFI

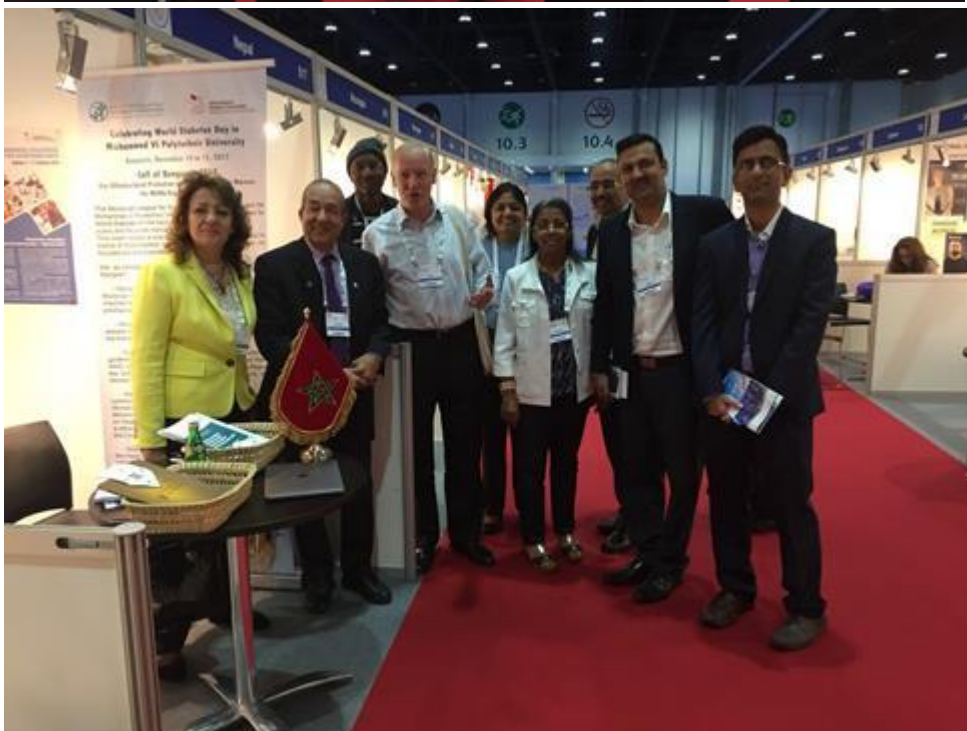
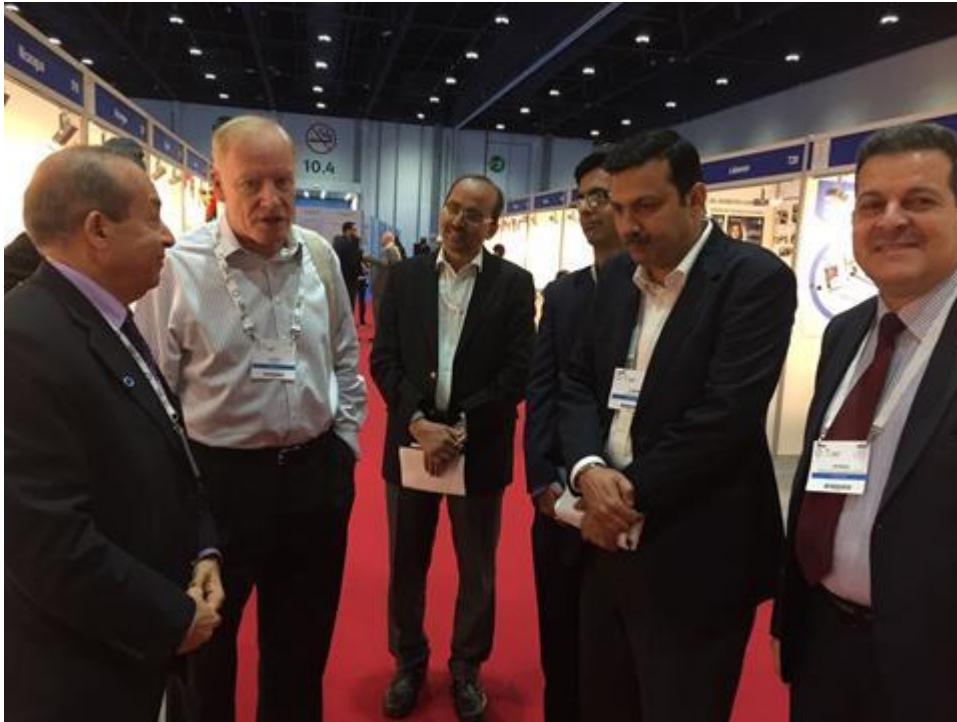
